

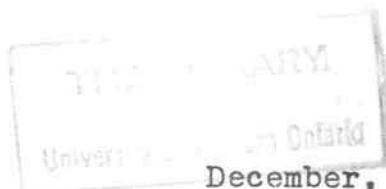

The speaker will be Mr. Dean Knight, who will talk on The Kleinburg Ossuary, an early historic burial complex, excavated this past summer by Dr. Jerry Melbye of the University of Toronto. Mr. Knight is a Ph.D. candidate at the University, and was field director for the Kleinberg project.
