Application Criteria

1. Application packages must be sent by e-mail to memberservices@ontarioarchaeology.org by February 22nd, 2021.
2. The application must be typed.
3. Incomplete packages will not be considered.
4. Applicants must be enrolled in a postsecondary institution/museum programme.
5. The research project must include the excavation and/or analysis of material culture remains from one or more Ontario archaeological sites.
6. Successful candidates will be contacted by March 31st, 2021.
7. Successful candidates will be required to submit receipts for supplies purchased/equipment rented to the OAS board to demonstrate appropriate use of the funds. In addition, a progress report detailing the status of the project must be submitted to the OAS board within one year of receiving funds.

Application Instructions

Please ensure the **Application Form Cover Page** is included with the package in addition to the following:

Cover Letter

This letter should briefly describe your research project and its contributions to Ontario archaeology. In addition, the use of the funds requested should be outlined. The cover letter should be an abstract for your award application.

Project Description and References Cited

Write a one to two-page description of your research project. Include appropriate background information to provide context about the contribution that your research will make to Ontario archaeology and the Ontario archaeological community. Please include a list of references cited following the *SAA Style Guide*.

Budget and Justification for Funds Request

Please provide a detailed budget breakdown of the funds requested for your research. A timeline to the completion of the portion of the project for which the funds are requested should also be provided. Please identify all other funding sources that you have obtained (e.g., university/programme specific awards, OGS, SSHRC, NSERC, etc.) pursuant to your current degree programme. Finally, please justify your request for funds from the OAS.

Reference Letter

Please have an individual, preferably a supervisor/advisor or colleague who is familiar with your research programme, provide a reference letter. This should be sent directly to the OAS director of membership services (memberservices@ontarioarchaeology.org). The letter should identify the length of your relationship with this individual, their role in your research programme, and their familiarity with your work and experience.
